OPERATING RULES

These rules are complementary to the Club 'Constitution and Rules'.

They may be changed from time to time by the committee as necessary to meet the requirements of the lease or for any other reason.

Members are permitted to stay on their boats overnight at the moorings for a maximum of 16 nights in any 2 month period.	The moorings are non-residential. Any time extension at the discretion of the committee.
Members are expected to keep the area around their boat mooring tidy.	
Items stored on the bank must be kept in storage containers. The containers must be of a neutral colour and must not exceed 6ft wide by 3ft deep by 3ft high.	CRT requirement.
The rubbish bin must only be used for domestic boat rubbish. Unwanted engine oil and bulky items must not be placed in the bin or left on site.	
Each boat-owning member may park not more than one car on the site alongside his mooring. Cars must not be parked so as to obstruct access.	
Temporary moorers are to park their car on the hard standing.
